



First aid at work course (2 days)

A worker has been injured or feels faint in the workplace: what should you do to help? While waiting for the emergency services, the first aider is the first link in the emergency chain. Become a first aider: learn the basics of first aid and strengthen your ability and confidence to act in emergency situations.

2-day First aid at work course allows the workers to acquire the required knowledge and competencies in accordance with the Code on Well-Being at Work of April 28th, 2017, Book 1st, Title 5 « First Aid ».

- Objectives**
- To know your role as a First Aider in the workplace.
 - To assess the situation, the severity of a discomfort or an injury and the need to call medical assistance.
 - To maintain vital functions and provide adequate first aid assistance in a life-threatening situation, recognize a serious medical condition or injury.

Content The first aid at work course is provided by the Belgian Red Cross as an accredited company by SPF Employment, Labor and Social Consultation.

3-day First aid at work course (consecutive or not), 18 hours of theory and practice:

- Legal framework
- Essential intervention rules (call 112)
- Control of vital functions
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation and defibrillation
- Recovery position, rollover technique
- Bleeding heavily
- Choking
- Having a seizure
- Respiratory distress
- Neurological disorders
- Head/Spine trauma and limbs injuries
- Feeling faint
- Serious wounds
- Severe burns
- Poisoning
- First Aid Kit

At the end of the course, after completing the course and successfully validating their First Aid knowledge, participants will receive a first aid certificate. The validity period of this certification is linked to the annual refresher course of minimum 4 hours.

- Methodology**
- Role plays
 - Hands-on exercises
 - Group exercises
 - Reflection/Discussion

Audience Everyone who wants to become a first aider at work.
Group from 4 to 12 participants.

- Organisation**
- Inter-enterprises: session in facilities reserved by the Belgian Red Cross for individual registration
 - Intra-enterprise: session within your organisation or in one of our rooms for a group:
→ Min. 40m² room, without tables fixed on the ground, furnished with a beamer, a whiteboard (screen or white wall), and a flipchart. If possible, a parking slot will be provided for our instructor.
